### Project Description

- Construct custom designed deck and an assortment of structures including timber pirate boat, and themed painted timber panels and a variety of timber bridges and ramps
- Install mixed hard surfaces of concrete, stabilized ryolite paths, paving, flagstone paving and soft-fall materials
- Install a range of musical items
- Install bins, modified drinking fountains and furniture for disabled access
- Install shade structures and play equipment
- Install sand pit with rock borders and co-ordinate the installation of the assorted decorative stone sculptures throughout the park
- Install Liberty swing for wheelchair access supplied by Variety, the Children's Charity
